

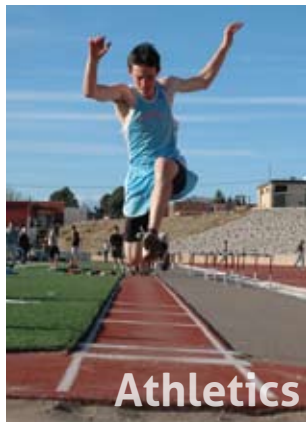
## ☀ Sandia Prep's Annual Fund and the Five A's
