News for Sandia Prep Families

Dear Parents,

I am fascinated with resilience, a characteristic that my heroes, Abraham Lincoln and educator John Dewey, exhibited in their lives and writing. Like many young men who grew as the biggest kid in the barnyard, it took me a while to discover, as the Japanese proverb suggests, “the bamboo that bends is stronger than the oak that resists.” To me, resilience and humility have always been connected. A humble person sees failure as an episode in a larger story—a source of information and correction—but not a deterrent to the dogged pursuit of what you know and feel is the right path.

Lincoln said this:

“It is said that an eastern monarch once charged his wise men to invent a sentence, to be ever in view, and which should be true and appropriate at all times and situations. They presented him with the words, ‘And this, too, shall pass away.’ How much it expressed! How chastening in the hour of pride! How consoling in the debts of affliction!”

I think a mantra that serves in moments of success and moments of challenge can bring you down to earth when you sail too high and pull you up when you find no wind to sustain you. You become resilient, and thus capable of continuous progress and learning, when you are guided by an optimistic attitude and surrounded by mentors who’ll help you recover from mistakes and disappointments, and who’ll have the courage to place your successes in appropriate context.

John Dewey said “experiences in order to be educative must lead out into an expanding world,” and that “the educator needs to view teaching and learning as a continuous process of reconstruction of experience.” You cannot reconstruct your learning experience in the classroom if you are too puffed up by your success in memorizing information for a standardized test. Nor can you become a resilient learner if you are defeated when your ideas are not tested and respected in an atmosphere where some autonomy and a license to learn remains in the hands of the student.

We hear so often that we are preparing today’s students for jobs that do not yet exist. The pace of change and the explosion of knowledge call for new skills and aptitudes. In the face of this challenge our colleagues in the public sector are pressed into testing concrete information endlessly. In the spirit of ‘these things, both positive and negative, shall pass away,’ we have taken a different path. Our goal is to meet the challenge with humility and confidence, and to help our students acquire the skills and strategies they’ll need to meet the future. We hope they learn to become resilient and expressive learners imbued with a sense of purpose and a curiosity too tough to diminish no matter what challenges impede their paths.
