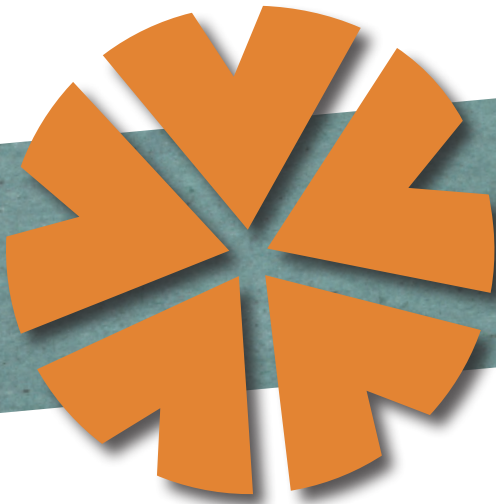

Applying for Financial Aid

We partner with School and Student Services by NAIS (SSS) in our financial aid process. Sandia Prep offers aid in the form of financial aid grants to families who demonstrate financial need. The amount of each grant varies, depending on the family's need and our available resources. Families are required to file for financial aid on an annual basis. Aid awards are typically similar from one year to the next unless financial circumstances have changed. Sandia Prep is unable to make an award until both the Parents' Financial Statement (PFS) and required tax documents are received. If parents are divorced or separated, both parents must participate in the financial aid process by each submitting a separate application directly to SSS. Late filing may jeopardize an award.
