What We Do

Grade-Level Events & Socials:

The SPSPA helps coordinate grade-level events throughout the year. Please consider hosting or attending the socials, as they are a great way to meet other families. Supply Store and Back-to-School Supply Sale:

The SPSPA operates the Sundevil Supply Store in the Russell Student Center. The all-volunteer-operated Sundevil Supply Store raises the bulk of SPSPA's revenues. The store generates income throughout the school year, but most of the revenue comes from the annual Back-to-School Supply Sale. This on-campus sale allows Prep families to purchase all necessary school supplies at a competitive price, in one convenient location, while supporting the Prep community.
